

Top Tips for Packing

Many of the travel tips from our clients focused on packing.

#1 Most Mentioned Tip - Pack Light!

Planning Ahead

- Packing list: "Plan ahead and use a packing list...it helps me remember everything I intend to bring." "Keep and modify list for future trips."
- Medication: "Remember to take prescription medication and any overthe-counter medication you might need."
- Extra bag: "Pack a soft bag or a duffle for the items that you buy on your trip."
- Carry-on essentials: "Pack carry-on with items you may need if your checked luggage is delayed or you have an unexpected overnight layover (e.g., medication, pajamas, change of clothes, toothbrush)."
- Luggage Specs: "Make sure your luggage is the right size/weight and has good wheels!"

Packing Essentials

- Pack lightly: "Pack as lightly as possible. Don't let luggage be a burden."
- Shoes: "You don't need all those shoes...I swear!"
- Carry-on: "Don't check bags if you can help it. It ends up in delays and lost bags."
- Packing cubes: "Use packing cubes and space saver bags to keep things organized and maximize the space."
- Layers: "Pack layers to accommodate for hot/cold weather (and plane flights too)."
- Comfortable shoes: "Bring a good pair of comfortable walking shoes. Road test them before you go!"
- Flashlight: "Bring a flashlight in case of power outages."

Bonus Laundry Tips

- "Utilize local laundry drop-off service (hotel laundry is expensive)."
- "Bring washable, quick dry items you can wash in the sink."
- "Pack travel size sink laundry detergent."

Travel Savvy Tips for a Perfect Trip



Research

- "Read as much as you can about where you're going."
- "Follow people on social media who live in/travel to places you're going."
- "Listen to Travel with Rick Steves podcasts and check out his website for great travel ideas and tips."



Organize

 "I make a Google doc for each trip which has train, plane, car and hotel reservations, sights suggestions, directions by public transit, where I plan to go, museum hours. etc."



For Foodies

- "Make lunch/dinner reservations before you go. Popular places are often booked months in advance."
- "Avoid eating at tourist locations: Get off the beaten path for meals.".



Just for Fun

- "We always choose small local hotels that include breakfast. It is fun to eat the local cuisine, saves time and money."
- "Use public transportation: It's a great way to see the city and is cost-effective."



Travel Insurance

- "Get travel insurance for big trips. It may seem like a waste of money, but if anything goes wrong it will pay for itself."
- "Use credit cards that have travel insurance."
- "It covers so much!...
 cancelled trip, medical
 emergencies, baggage
 loss, travel delays, etc."



Be Flexible

- "Remain flexible and be prepared for pitfalls.
 Flights can be delayed; hotels can mix-up reservations...don't let it ruin your trip!"
- "Go with the flow and maintain your sense of humor."
- "Don't get too stuck on your plan."

Travel Savvy Tips for a Perfect Trip



Passports/Customs Rules

- "Make sure your passport is valid for at least six months beyond the dates of your trip."
- "Before traveling to another country, it's crucial to check its customs regulations to avoid problems with prohibited or restricted items."



Be Prepared

- "Plan, plan, plan and prepare a back-up plan."
- "Be prepared for the weather at your destinations."
- "Many sights need to be booked 30-90 days in advance—especially dring peak season."



Travel Agents

- "Use a travel agent. It minimizes the stress, and they have insider knowledge and deals/perks."
- "Hire private/local guides for a more personal experience."
- "Customize travel plans tailored to your unique interests."



Embrace the Culture

- "Learn the basics of the language when you are in a foreign country.
 Hello, please and thank you go a long way and are much appreciated by the locals."
- "Be open to new things
 —food, people and cultures."
- "Try something entirely new!"



Security

- "Make copies of important documents.
 Scan your passport, IDs, and insurance, and save them in the cloud or email to yourself."
- "Keep passport in hotel safe when possible and carry a copy around town."
- "Be security oriented."



Enjoy the Journey!

- "Don't overschedule your trip. Allow yourself time to relax into the local culture and just be."
- "Be impulsive."
- "Be open to new experiences & the 'awe' of whatever comes your way."
